You'll be based at our city campus; a vibrant hive of activity in the heart of Coventry, with fantastic facilities including dedicated social and study spaces and our Learning Hub, which is full of resources to support your studies.





SUPPORT YOUNEED

We understand that returning to education in adult life is a big step. That's why we offer a range of services to support you from your initial enquiry right up to when you've completed your programme and beyond.

APPLICATION SESSIONS

If you need support with applying for a programme or have any questions about which programme is best for you, you can **book onto one of our Application Sessions**. One of our friendly Admissions Team will work through your application with you.

CAREERS

Our Careers Team can provide you with advice and guidance on choosing the right programme, progression options, employment, developing your CV and preparing for interviews. All of which will help you to develop the confidence and resilience to achieve your career goals.

LEARNER SERVICES TEAM

The Learner Services Team are here to work with you to offer a **positive wellbeing service throughout your time at college**. They support with all aspects of college life, including mental health and wellbeing support, personal and academic development.

ADDITIONAL LEARNING SUPPORT

If you have additional learning needs, a disability or simply need a little extra help with your studies, our Additional Learning Support Team are here for you. The team offers everything from in-class support and mobility support to social and emotional care. We also offer facilities for those who are hard of hearing or visually impaired.



FUNDING SUPPORT

Getting the support you need financially to help you complete a programme can make a big difference. Think of it as investing in you and your future.

If you're aged 19+ you may need to pay for your programme. The **fees you pay will depend on the type of programme you choose and your current circumstances**. There are a number of schemes, loans, grants and bursaries available to help you pay for your programme and other related costs. Plus, **you may be able to study one of our programmes for free**, depending on your circumstances. Here's some of the support you may be able to access.

ADVANCED LEARNER LOAN

You can apply for an Advanced Learner Loan to help with the costs of your college course. Loan eligibility doesn't depend on your income and there are no credit checks.

You won't have to pay this back until you've completed your programme and your salary is above the threshold set by the government.

LEARNER SUPPORT FUND

The College's Learner Support Fund is there to help remove barriers to learning and enable more learners to access education. You may be able to access the:

- ▶ 19+ Learner Support Fund if you're aged 19+ on 31 August (in the year you plan to start your programme) and haven't taken out an Advanced Learner Loan, your income is below £26,000 and you've enrolled onto a Further Education course (Level 3 or below)
- ▶ Advanced Learner Loan Bursary if you're aged 19+ on 31 August (in the year you plan to start your programme) and you've been approved for an Advanced Learner Loan, your income is below £30,000 and you've enrolled onto a Further Education course (Level 3 or below).



FEE REMISSION

If you're aged 19+ you won't need to pay programme fees if:

- You choose to study an Entry or Level 1 programme or GCSE Maths and English, and you have not already achieved GCSE grade A-C / 7-4
- You're in receipt of unemployment benefits or universal credits, and you choose to study a Level 1 or 2 programme

TUITION FEE AND MAINTENANCE LOANS

If you choose to study a Higher Education programme you may able to apply for a Tuition Fee Loan and a Maintenance Loan. You won't have to pay these back until you've completed your programme and your salary is above the threshold set by the government.

NATIONAL FUNDING SCHEMES

There are a number of national funding schemes you may be able to access including:

- ► The Childcare Grant, which helps with up to 85% of childcare costs
- ► The Parents' Learning Allowance to help with programme related costs if you have dependent children
- ► The Adult Dependants' Grant, which you may be able to access if you have adults who depend on you financially
- The Disabled Students' Allowance, if you may incur additional costs because of a disability, long-term health condition, mental health condition or learning difficulty

FREE AND PART-FUNDED PROGRAMMES

DEPENDING ON YOUR CIRCUMSTANCES AND EXISTING QUALIFICATIONS YOU MAY BE ABLE TO ACCESS A FREE OR PART-FUNDED PROGRAMME THANKS TO TWO GOVERNMENT SCHEMES.

NATIONAL SKILLS FUND

The National Skills Fund aims to help adults train and gain the valuable skills they need to improve their job prospects.

To access a free or part-funded programme you must be aged 19 or over, not already hold a Level 3 qualification and be accepted onto an eligible programme.

FREE PROGRAMMES FOR THE UNEMPLOYED

We also offer free programmes for those looking to get back into employment.

WEST MIDLANDS COMBINED AUTHORITY (WMCA) FUNDING

If you're a resident in the WMCA, some programmes could also be fully-funded.

You must be aged 19 or over on August 31 (in the year you plan to start your programme) and be a resident of the WMCA to be eligible.

Funding is subject to an assessment based on your individual circumstances and acceptance onto an eligible programme.






