



Student Transfer Arrangements

Coventry college does not have a formal student transfer arrangement. However, if you're currently studying Higher Education at another provider or internally at Coventry college and want to transfer to another course at the college or externally. Please contact student services hello@coventrycollege.ac.uk for guidance. Each transfer request will be considered individually and the college will support you through the process.

A student's eligibility for transfer will be assessed by our academic staff on an individual basis and will be based on the following:

- approval from the validating University or awarding body in line with their academic rules and regulations
- meeting the entry-requirements
- compatibility of the modules/grades of your previous study against your chosen course and its modules
- analysis of the transcripts of your first and/or second year studies. (Please note that no decision will be made on your application until we receive a copy of the transcripts of your previous study (or, if you are still yet to complete this study, a partial transcript including details of all outstanding modules)
- quality of your academic reference and personal statement (if applicable).

Our main intake of transferring students would be in our September enrolment. If you want to start at Coventry College in September, you need to apply through the Universities and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS).
